
HEART LOG CABIN BLOCK

This block is worked in three sections.



Section C

Section A

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1 BG 3 1/2" square
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- 2 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" + 1 1/2" square BG
- 3 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" + 1 1/2" square BG

Section B

- 4 1 1/2" square (piece 4 and piece 13 should be same fabric)
- 5 1 1/2" square
- 6 2 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 7 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" (piece 7 and piece 16 should be same fabric)
- 8 3 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 9 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" + 1 1/2" square BG

Section C

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10 1 1/2" square
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- 11 1 1/2" square
- 12 2 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 13 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" (piece 13 and piece 4 should be same fabric)
- 14 2 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 15 4 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 16 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" (piece 16 and piece 7 should be same fabric)
- 17 3 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 18 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" + 1 1/2" square BG

First do the "stitch and flips", Mark the four 1 1/2" squares of BG diagonally. Stitch on strips 2, 3, 9, and 18. Make sure you put the BG square in the correct direction! Trim and press.

Follow the diagram to stitch the pieces in each section together going by numerical order.

Sew sections together—matching seams.

Done!

If you want the heart to stand up rather than on it's side. Take two 5 3/4" square blocks of BG fabric. Slice each one diagonally. Add to opposite corners. Press. Add the other two to the opposite corners. Press. Trim to 10 1/4"--make sure you have a 1/4" seam on the heart's bottom point.
